What is the role of REMU (Regional Emergency Management Unit) in Food for Work Program?

The REMU elects a Regional Food for Work Technical Committee which will be chaired by the Chief Regional Officer with the Regional Rural Development Planner as its secretary.

What are the roles of Regional Food for work Technical Committee?

The Committee will approve or reject or defer FFW projects applications in their region and communicate such info to REMU or the Food for Work Secretariat.

The committee should also provide encouragement as well as support in writing up of project proposals and monitor approved projects as well as to ensure that projects received food and non-food items.

The committee should also monitor all movements of Food for Work activities
